Nail capping and backing together using 50 mm nails creating an $L$ shape and slot on the top and fix every $4^{\text {th }}$ board through to the backing

All fence bays should be 3.0 m between post centres until the last bay of fencing. Cut rails and gravel boards to complete last


## Basic Steps

1. Concrete posts 3.0 m between centre of posts (end posts can be installed first and then stringed to identify a straight fence line).
2. Gravel boards can be bolted onto face of posts, then drill and bolt rails to the face of the posts.
3. Ready to pale. Sit feather boards on the gravel board, overlap each board by $25-30 \mathrm{~mm}$ and nail through thick edge of feather boards.
4. Capping and backing can now be assembled with 50 mm nails and slotted between posts and feather edge
